The Community Fund for Carmel Valley (CFCV) is a way for caring people to come together to thoughtfully address these local needs. Growing the CFCV helps protect and improve the quality of life for local residents.

## Neighbors Helping Neighbors

In 2020 the Community Fund for Carmel Valley was created to offer residents, businesses and organizations an opportunity to contribute to the greater good of others in the valley. The CFCV seeks to improve the lives of our fellow community members, both now and in the future. The fund has the flexibility to respond to immediate needs and make grants to assist our community. Grants support the greater Carmel Valley area from Highway One to Cahoon Grade. The CFCV is an affiliate fund of the Community Foundation for Monterey County, which provides administrative, investment and grantmaking expertise.

## Mission

To protect and improve the quality of life for all residents and support and foster the vibrancy of the Carmel Valley community.

## Grantmaking Impact - \$300,000 Granted

Thanks to generous community support, the CFCV has granted \$300,000 since its inception to strengthen Carmel Valley, including \$188,000 for relief and recovery from the 2020 fires and \$27,000 for the 2023 floods, and ongoing annual support to local nonprofits, through grantmaking. Fund Priorities include:

- Build community, improve infrastructure and meet local needs
- Expand youth programming and services
- Support educational, cultural and historical programs
- Support nonprofits serving the greater Carmel Valley area
- Enable rapid response to community crises, meeting emergency needs and providing disaster relief
- Build funds to meet future needs
