Simplify Your Giving—Create a Donor Advised Fund

Donor advised funds at the Community Foundation for Monterey County (CFMC) help simplify and maximize the impact of your giving. You make a tax deductible gift to establish your fund and recommend grants over time to the causes you care about. You benefit from the convenience and community knowledge of our professional staff.

How it Works—it's Simple

- You can start your fund with a gift of \$5,000 or more (using cash, appreciated stock, real estate, or other assets).
- A fund is established in your name, in the name of your family or business, or in honor of any person or organization you choose.
- Family members can be named as donor advisors and successor donor advisors.
- You receive tax benefits in the year your gift is made.
- You recommend grants from your fund—working with our professional program staff to support the causes you care about most in Monterey County and beyond.
- We handle all administrative details and issue grants to nonprofits in the name of your fund. (If you prefer, grants can be made anonymously).

Fund types:

- Non-endowed – You can recommend grants up to the full balance of the fund.
- Endowed – A percentage of the fund is made available for grantmaking each year.
- You can add to your fund at anytime, or include the fund in a legacy gift through your estate. There is no minimum balance needed to maintain your fund.
